AN ENDANGERED AUSTRALIAN PLANT OR ANIMAL

For homework this week you are to research an endangered Australian plant or animal. Remember "animal" includes seashells and small sea creatures, crabs, fish, worms, insects, spiders, frogs, reptiles, birds, mammals. "Plant" includes trees, small shrubs, small flowering plants, grasses, seaweed.

To find a list of endangered plants or animals, Google endangered plants of Australia or endangered animals of Australia.

Research what the plant or animal looks like, where it is found, what has caused it to become endangered. You must be able to present your information to the class.

You can select from a variety of presentation methods such as

- a model made from recycled material
- a diorama (a view of the plant or animal, in its environment, built in a small box)
- a computer presentation that can be shown to the class
- information and illustrations on a sheet of cardboard, or a big sheet of paper, to be hung in the class room (Your writing must be very neat in this presentation.)
- writing and illustrating in a book to be shown to the class.
